Mr. Bogardus is a Senior Counsel in the Hartford office of the Small Business/Self-Employed Division of the Office of Chief Counsel. For the past 20 years, Mr. Bogardus has primarily represented the IRS in litigation before the United States Tax Court. Mr. Bogardus has received 16 published opinions from the Tax Court, ranging from individual taxpayer issues, to collection matters, to \$100 million dollar tax shelters.
